GOD IS WITH US

Today is the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. While thinking of this family, I cannot stop thinking about the families whose lives are deeply affected by the senseless and violent killings of their children while at school. The tragedy they experience demonstrates the vulnerability of human

life, particularly, the vulnerability of children. They come into the world completely dependent upon their mothers for care and nourishment and upon their parents for protection from the vulnerability that children cannot articulate. In a poignant way, children are vulnerable to the power of evil that works in the world.

The Holy Family, likewise, experienced vulnerability and tragedy. Here are some examples as recorded in the Scriptures: St. Luke tells us that there was no room for them in the inn (homeless for the night); St. Matthew tells us that there was a death threat regarding Jesus, and the family had to flee to Egypt (refugees for years); St. Luke tells us the experience of a lost child in Jerusalem who is found in the temple (emotional anguish for parents); lastly, we are all familiar with the Gospel account of the arrest of Jesus, his trial before Pilate, and his violent crucifixion and death (religious persecution). These events in the life of the Holy Family teach us that their experience of life included vulnerability and tragedy. They were not shielded from these realities that we all experience.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that "Christ's whole life is a mystery of redemption. Redemption comes to us above all through the blood of his cross, but this mystery is at work throughout Christ's entire life:

- already in his Incarnation through which by becoming poor he enriches us with his poverty;
- in his hidden life which by his submission atones for our disobedience;
- in his word which purifies its hearers;
- in his healings and exorcisms by which 'he took our infirmities and bore our diseases';
- and in his Resurrection by which he justifies us" (CCC 517).

And so, we, in the face of our vulnerabilities and tragedies, are invited to fix our gaze upon Christ who ". . . enables us to live in him all that he himself lived, and he lives it in us" (CCC 521). Christ is united with every person through all the stages and experiences of life. He is not separated from us in our trials, difficulties, and tragedies. No, he is present in all of our experiences so that we may find our hope and our strength in him. He has the power to bring the triumph of love and grace into our lives.

The life of the Holy Family "revolved" around the person of Jesus. Through him, they discovered the will of God for their lives; through him, they witnessed the power of God to heal the human person of physical and spiritual infirmities; through him, they discovered the divine answer to the questions and realities of evil and death. A continual focus upon the person of Jesus enabled them to accept and persevere through the mysteries of evil, vulnerability, and tragedy.

This Feast of the Holy Family offers us the opportunity to renew our focus upon the person of Jesus and to engage our life with his. We have today the opportunity and grace to reorient our attention so that our lives revolve around his. The life of holiness does not mean that our lives are without trials; rather, the life of holiness means that we live each day with our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of our faith (cf. Heb 12:2). From him we discover and experience that he is Emmanuel—God is with us. By his triumph over sin and death, he is more powerful than all the evil in the universe. He is our hope.

Thanks to all who helped make our celebration of Christmas joyful, meaningful, and beautiful. And a special thanks to all who made a donation for the Christmas flowers. May the Lord bless all who have given gifts of time, talent, and treasure so that we may worthily celebrate the Christmas feasts.


