# **OVERVIEW**

St. Gertrude Church is committed to supporting parents in the Christian formation of their children. We are happy to offer various child-centered and family-focused faith formation programs for children age three to grade six.

We have also developed discipleship-oriented offerings for those in junior high and high school. These offerings are rooted in our universal call to holiness, a respect for the developmental needs of adolescents, the need to support parents in this key developmental period, and the Gospel commission to "go and make disciples" (c.f. Mt. 28:19). For junior high teens (seventh and eighth graders), this includes a period of preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation, which teens receive in eighth grade.

For high school teens, this includes large group and small group experiences of shared prayer, communal life, clear and relevant teaching, and opportunities to live the apostolate.

# Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Children 3 Years Old\*-Grade 3

# PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

St. Gertrude Church offers Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS), a Montessori-influenced faith formation experience for children ages three\* through grade three. The CGS experience is threefold: the child, the adult catechist, and the prepared environment called the atrium, which is filled with beautifully handmade child-sized materials. While in the atrium, children are invited into prayer, given a presentation that is based on Scripture or liturgy, and allotted time for personal work. The catechist guides every child's need to "help me come closer to God by myself." St. Gertrude Church is happy to offer CGS Level 1 (for children ages 3\*-6) and Level 2 (for children in grades 1-3).

## **SESSION TIMES**

Children meet for at least 75 minutes each week in one of the atria at St. Gertrude Church. Weekly sessions allow children to gain a true familiarity with the environment and the catechist, which deepens their experience.

Parents who wish to bring their child forward to receive First Reconciliation and First Communion in second grade should be sure to enroll their child in Catechesis of the Good Shepherd as a first grader (if not before).

# Sacramental Formation (Parent/Child)

Generally for Children in Grade 2

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

With parents being the primary educators of their children, St. Gertrude Church collaborates with you in the year of preparation for the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion. The monthly Sacramental Formation sessions with your child are Scripture-based, include key Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) presentations, and provide the practical knowledge needed to receive the aforementioned sacraments. These times of catechesis and prayer will become sacred memories for you and your child.

# **PROGRAM ELEMENTS & SESSION TIMES**

If your child attends a public or private school that does not teach CGS, you need to register him or her for CGS Level 2 and Sacramental Formation. If your primary form of education is homeschooling, you need to register your child for Sacramental Formation; however, participation in CGS Level 2 is also encouraged!

# **Family Faith**

Children in Grades 4-6

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Perhaps startlingly, research has shown that children typically begin to make key decisions about belief in God and practice of faith in fifth grade. And though it may be hard to see when we are in the thick of family life, the influence of parents in children's faith journeys is of first importance.

With that knowledge, we offer Family Faith, a family-focused, child-centered formation for children in grades 4-6. In Family Faith, parents and children gather once a month for fellowship, hands-on activities, and opportunities to learn and pray together.

Each month, we also host a second session just for the children. This second meeting reviews the presentation from the family meeting and allows the children time to talk, play, and learn with their peers through hands-on projects.

## **SESSION TIMES**

Family Faith meets two times per month, once with parents and children together, and once with children only.

- 1st & 3rd Tuesdays\*, 6-7:15 p.m.

#### **Please Note**

- This program happens simultaneously with Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. If you have younger children (ages 3-9) in your family, they will be in the atrium at the same time you (parents) and your children in grades 4-6 are in the school cafeteria for Family Faith.
- Junior high and high school students are encouraged to attend Family Faith as well, at no cost. Even if the content is ultimately geared toward children in grades 4-6, there is always something to learn, and older children have an opportunity to teach their younger siblings.

# **Confirmation Preparation**

Youth in Grades 7-8

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our sacramental formation for Confirmation aims to help young men and women grow in understanding of the faith and deepen their relationship with Christ and his Church. It also gives these teens the confidence they need to be light in their homes, schools, and social settings. We offer a two-year formation process for all seventh and eighth graders of the parish who wish to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church through the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation at the end of their eighth grade year.\* Those who intend to receive the sacrament will commit to participate in formation meetings consisting of activities, talks, small group discussions, and prayer experiences, along with several other commitments and events, including a Personal Spiritual Plan (done with parents and mentors), a retreat, a teaching Mass, and sponsor/candidate formation.

- Personal Spiritual Plans: Regular meetings throughout the year with parents and mentors
- Teaching Mass (attend one of two options): Tuesday, January 16 or 30, 2024

# **COST**

Sacramental formation for Confirmation costs \$80/child.

\*St. Gertrude School, homeschooled, and other Catholic school students are welcome and encouraged to participate in our Confirmation Preparation program as a supplement to in-class instruction; however, they are not required to participate in the entire program to be confirmed at the parish. Some key elements may still be expected. Contact the coordinator of youth formation to learn more and to determine the best support for your child's formation.

# Junior High Youth Ministry

Youth in Grades 7-8

# PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

As young men and women enter adolescence, they begin to take ownership and direction of their lives, to wrestle with questions like, "What is happiness?", "Where do I fit in?", "Who do I want to be?" Our junior high youth ministry invites emerging adolescents in grades seven and eight to ask those questions, form deeper friendships, receive guidance from mentors, and live more deeply from their identities as sons and daughters of the living God.

## PROGRAM ELEMENTS & SESSION TIMES

Our junior high youth ministry consists of small groups and other activities throughout the school year. Once we have a list of young men and women who are interested in joining these small groups, we will work with parents and families to find groups mentors in faith and life who will meet with these small groups to share the Christian vision for fullness of life. Small group meeting dates and times will be determined by parents and group participants.

## **COST**

There is no cost to join a small group. Other activities may have a cost and are at the discretion of the participants.
