# The Fridge Sheet: Your Salvation History

This month we took a tour through Salvation History. We saw that over and over again, God makes covenants with his people—drawing them into a family relationship with him. We call this Salvation History, because humans consistently fall into sin, breaking the covenant and needing to be saved from our own brokenness. This plays out in our own lives as well.
